



VAU is an all-volunteer nonprofit, founded and run by Veterans. Our sole purpose is to honor of our Nation's Fallen Heroes from the Global World on Terror as well as their Gold Star Families through our VAU Fallen Heroes Memorial while having a positive impact on our Nation's communities. This 28 foot wide by 6 foot tall American flag symbolizes the shape of the flag when draped on a fallen service members casket. It is designed out of the close to 7000 dog tags of all those who have fallen in the War on Terror. There are 50 gold stars honoring all gold star families nationwide. Displayed in front of the flag is a battle field cross sculpted from mahogany wood by female veteran artist Alicia Dietz. https://www.vetsau.com/memorial

We have 2 traveling memorial flags located in St. Louis, Mo and Richmond, Va area. We request a base display fee of \$3500 for locations within 200 miles of these 2 areas for a weekend display. This helps us to cover all costs associated with transporting the flag and other expenses required to keep the flags traveling. We are all veteran volunteers and do not make any money off the flag. Any remaining proceeds from memorial events are used towards long term maintenance of the flag and to support gold star family organizations.

If your event is located outside of the 200 mile range of the 2 memorial HQ locations or the requested display dates are longer than a weekend time frame, then we will review the application and provide an estimated display fee for your event.

If you cannot find a sponsor or cover the minimum \$3500 fee or the provided event estimate, then please let us know what amount you are willing to donate towards displaying the memorial at your event.

Average travel costs are \$1.25/ mile, \$200/per night lodging, \$600-\$1200 rental truck and \$134 meals (per day/per two volunteers). Larger cities may be slightly higher than these average costs.

While we are very grateful of the abundant number of requests, we do need to be selective of applications. As soon as it is received, your application will go through a process of VAU Board review and scheduling. We will notify you as soon as possible if your location has been approved. We appreciate your patience during this process. We understand that the timing of a specific event may be a large factor in your date selection, however, we ask that you consider several available dates as it may be advantageous to group several events together within a certain proximity.

Requirements

- Minimum 28' wide x by 6' tall (clear height) flat solid surface area. The Battlefield cross is placed 4' in front of flag and back angle supports are placed behind the flag 2-4ft depth with sand bag stabilizers;
- Minimum 4-5 volunteers for set up and break down capable of lifting minimum of 50 lbs;
- If the memorial will be displayed for a long period of time and our memorial travel coordinator is not available, one of the host volunteers need to be knowledgeable on break down of the dog tag panels in case of emergency wind of over 30mph. If placed outside we will need something solid to ratchet strap backside of the memorial. Fence, concrete pillars, sturdy yard stakes etc.


